With exhibit flooring being a mandatory feature of many shows (IACP 2024 included), some exhibitors have wondered how they can meet the requirement in a sustainable fashion. Fortunately, there are a number of “green” flooring options available, writes expert David Wallens for [Exhibitor Magazine](#). He recommends that exhibitors consider using sustainably-produced natural materials or reusable flooring made from recycled products.

[Warning on Non-Official Contractors:](#)

Conference exhibitors are targeted regularly by third-party contractors touting ‘Free’ Show Guide Listings and urgent reminders to book housing or other services. Beware of these solicitations, especially as IACP 2024 gets closer. ***The IACP does not sell exhibitor contact information to any third-party vendor.*** Unfortunately, many of these companies scour the internet to gather information to target exhibitors. A listing of IACP Official Contractors is available on the [Exhibitor Resources](#) page of the IACP 2024 website. To avoid scams, please research any vendors which are not listed as IACP Official Contractors and avoid making any “quick” decisions if pressured.
